





# PADOVA MARATHON

# Euganeo Stadium - Padua, April 27th 2025

# **OFFICIAL RULEBOOK**

Assindustria Sport Ltd., amateur sports club has received approval from the National Italian Track and Field Federation to organize the 25<sup>th</sup> edition of the Padova Marathon.

This is a race of 42,195 km, which course was measured and certified in 2011 by AIMS/World Athletics and will take place on Sunday, April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025 with start at 8:30 am at the Euganeo Stadium and arrival in Padua, Prato della Valle.

### **PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS**

- A. The race is open to all participants who have reached 20 years of age by the year 2025 and who hold a membership card from FIDAL (Italian Track and Field Federation) or from a foreign Federation affiliated with World Athletics and holding authorization to compete abroad. These athletes must provide also copy of the self-certification that can be downloaded from the website <a href="https://www.padovamarthon.com">www.padovamarthon.com</a>.
- B. The race is also open to all participants who have reached 20 years of age by the year 2025 and don't hold a membership card from FIDAL or from World Athletics but hold a RUNCARD (issued at the age of 20), which allows athletes to participate at running events in Italy for one year and can be purchased on the website <a href="www.runcard.com">www.runcard.com</a>. These athletes must provide also a health certificate (or the equivalent Health Form downloadable from <a href="www.padovamarathon.com">www.padovamarathon.com</a>) attesting to the fact that their physical conditions are such to allow performance at competitive levels in athletics issued and signed by a sports medicine specialist or by a centre for sports medicine as required by the Italian law. This certificate must be still valid on April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- C. Athletes affiliated FISPES/FSSI in the following categories recognised by the Federations: Olympic wheelchairs (T51, T52, T53 e T54), Blind and Partially Sighted (T11, T12, T13), Amputated (T44 e T46), Brain-damaged (T37 e T38), Intellectual-relational (T20), Deaf. Blind athletes are required to personally provide their guide and Wheelchairs to wear helmets.

# **FOREIGN RUNNERS - NON-COMPETITIVE RACE**

D. The race is open to all **foreign athletes residing abroad** from 20 years old **who intend to participate as non-competitive runners**. These athletes, who are not members of a Sports Club affiliated with FIDAL or IAAF/World Athletics and **don't hold a health certificate for athletics**, must sign a **consent form** during the registration process. **Warning**: By choosing this option, the athletes will be included in the results only with the race time without the position and without the category, and they will not be able to receive any prizes.

All participants must waive Assindustria Sport - Padova Marathon of any responsibility regarding the suitability of their physical condition to compete in the race and they must declare that they have trained adequately for the marathon.

#### **ENTRY FEES AND PROCEDURES**

Entry fees are as follow:

- ➤ **€ 38,00** from 25/07/2024 to 30/09/2024
- ➤ **€ 44,00** from 01/10/2024 to 15/12/2024
- ➤ **€ 55,00** from 16/12/2024 to 15/02/2025
- **€ 65,00** from 16/02/2025 to 11/04/2025
- ➤ € 85,00 at the Expo subject to bib numbers availability

Please note: Registrations will be closed upon reaching 2000 participants.

# **SPECIAL OFFERS**

- > WOMAN: € 38,00 from 25/07/2024 to 30/09/2024, then fixed fee € 44,00 until 11/04/2025.
- CLUB SPECIAL: every 5 people registered for the Marathon by the same sports club one of them is FREE until 11/04/2054. The 5 registrations must be sent AT THE SAME TIME and complete with all the details.







Registrations can be processed as follows:

- **Online**: fill in the online registration form available on the website <a href="www.padovamarathon.com">www.padovamarathon.com</a> and pay by credit card (Visa, Mastercard, Eurocard and PayPal are accepted).
- Personally at Assindustria Sport Office at Stadio Daciano Colbachini, Piazzale Azzurri d'Italia 35134 Padova Italy.

During the registration process, all non-card holders will be obliged to provide a **copy of a medical certificate** (attesting to the fact that the athlete's physical conditions are such as to allow performance at competitive levels) or the equivalent health form issued and signed by a sports medicine specialist or by a centre for sports medicine. This certificate must be valid on April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Athletes who register by e-mail must provide copy of the health certificate to the address iscrizioni@padovamarathon.com before the race.

#### **REFUND OF ENTRY FEE**

Entry fees are not refundable in case you decide not to take part to the race. Anyway, you can:

- transfer your registration fee to Padova Marathon 2026 by previously informing the organizers by e-mail (<u>iscrizioni@padovamarathon.com</u>) until 11/04/2025. The confirmation of the participation to the Padova Marathon 2026 undergoes the payment of € 10,00 for secretarial rights.
- transfer your registration to another runner by previously informing the organizers by e-mail (<u>iscrizioni@padovamarathon.com</u>) until 11/04/2025. In case of "name change" you will be asked to **pay extra €** 10,00 for secretarial rights.

WARNING! Marathon and Half Marathon are two different races, with different bib numbers and chips. The possibility to change race depends on the availability of bibs and undergoes the payment of € 10,00. In case of race change from Half Marathon to Marathon you will also be asked to integrate the registration fee: the difference will be calculated with respect to the fee valid at the moment of the transfer.

Transfer of race on the marathon morning ARE NOT POSSIBLE, you will not be in any of the result lists!

#### **SERVICES INCLUDED IN THE ENTRY FEE**

- bib
- official t-shirt
- insurance and medical assistance during the race
- refreshment and sponging along the racecourse
- goody bag
- official program and technical information
- transport of personal clothing from the start area to the finish area
- pre-race and post-race transportation by shuttle buses
- official medal
- Marathon diploma

## **BIB NUMBER DISTRIBUTION**

Bib numbers will be distributed automatically on the basis of the best personal time made in the last 2 years, declared by the participants and confirmed by FIDAL statistics, and on the basis of the registration date.

For this reason, the Organization cannot satisfy requests for a specific number, nor can it change numbers that have already been assigned, even in cases where the athlete has inadvertently failed to specify his/her personal best.

101 - 300	Athletes with times under 3 hours
301 - 1000	Athletes with times between 3 and 3 h 30
1101 - 2000	Athletes with times between 3 h 30 and 4 h

#### **BIB PICK UP**

The bib number is strictly personal and cannot be given to others or exchanged. It must be pinned to the chest with four safety pins so that it is completely visible; it should not be folded and it must be preserved in good condition.

Athletes will be able to pick up their bibs at the **Expo Village in the Fair of Padova** (Via Niccolò Tommaseo, 59) on the following days:

- Thursday April 24th from 3:00 pm to 8:00 pm
- Friday April 25th from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm
- Saturday April 26<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm

ATTENTION! BIBS WILL NOT BE DELIVERED ON THE RACE DAY ON SUNDAY MORNING.

To get the bib-number it will be necessary to hand out ad identity document.

#### **GOODY BAGS PICK UP**

Athletes will find a voucher for the goody bag pick up with their bib numbers. Goody bags can be picked up at the **Expo Village in the Fair of Padova** on the following days:

- Thursday April 24th from 3:00 pm to 8:00 pm
- Friday April 25<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm
- Saturday April 26th from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm

ATTENTION! GOODY BAGS WILL NOT BE DELIVERED ON THE RACE DAY.

Goody bags won't be handed out to athletes who will not give the proper voucher.

#### **PARKING**

Together with the bib number, all the athletes registered for the marathon will receive a **parking pass** which will allow them to leave their cars in the following parking areas:

- **in Padua**, at the **Euganeo Stadium**. Coming to Padua via the A4 highway, take the "Padova Ovest" exit. Coming via the A13 highway, take the "Padova Sud" exit and follow the signs to the "Stadio Euganeo" which are found throughout the city.

It will be possible to park in the reserved spaces by arriving no later than 7:15 a.m.

Please make sure that the parking pass is clearly visible and placed on the dashboard inside your car.

The organizers refuse all responsibility for the objects left unattended inside the cars.

#### TRANSPORT SERVICES TO THE START LINE

Before the marathon there will be a free shuttle service to the start line at the Euganeo Stadium. The shuttles will leave from:

- Padua railway station (departing the railway station entrance) from 6:45 am to 7:15 am
- Padua, Prato della Valle (in front of Basilica of Santa Giustina) at 7:00 am
- <u>For the relatives</u> who will accompany athletes at the Euganeo Stadium there will be a **free shuttle service** to Prato della Valle **at 9:00 a.m**. (departing from Viale Nereo Rocco).

# **BAGS FOR PERSONAL BELONGINGS**

At the start line, athletes can give the bag containing their personal belongings to the appropriate courier **by 7.30 am** by previously attaching the **identification sticker with the bib number**, which they will find inside the envelope containing the bib. The athletes will be able to pick up their bags from the courier trucks after the race in Prato Della Valle.

Athletes are strongly recommended not to put in their personal bag objects of value and to only insert extremely necessary garments. Heavy and huge bags (such as trolleys and luggage) won't be accepted.

Personal bags will be handed out only if athletes will exhibit their bib number.







#### TRANSPORT SERVICES AFTER THE RACE

After the marathon there will be a free shuttle service to return to the start line at the Euganeo Stadium:

- from Prato della Valle to the **Euganeo Stadium (with in-between stop in Padova Railway Station)**: from 12:00 a.m. to 4.30 a.m., departures every 30' minutes (500 m after the finish line on Via Manzoni)

#### **THE START**

The start of the marathon is set for **8:30 a.m.** Slight variations in the starting time may be caused by the live television broadcast of the event.

To guarantee a smooth start, all runners are requested to arrive at the start line of Euganeo Stadium no later than 7:30 am.

#### **RACE COURSE**

The race starts outside the Euganeo Stadium in Padua, on Viale Nereo Rocco. Through Via Due Palazzi, the race course reaches the quarter of Montà, Ponterotto and then enters the SP55 towards Rubano. After the roundabout of Villaguattera, it continues on Via Mazzini and gets to the intersection with SR11, which is covered for about 850 mt. Through Via Ceresina, it enters Selvazzano Dentro and runs along Via Pelosa (Roman age road) until it gets to SP82. Past the bridge on the Bacchiglione river, it goes through the city centre of Selvazzano Dentro and through Via Scapacchiò it runs next to the Golf Club "La Montecchia". Near the 20th km, it enters the municipality of Teolo and continues on Via dei Colli until it gets to the intersection with Via Abbazia di Praglia, from where it continues towards Abano Terme. The race course continues towards the centre of Abano Terme through Via Cornelio Augure, Via Abano, Viale Terme, Piazza della Repubblica, Viale delle Terme, Via Matteotti, Via S. Pio X, Viale Roveri, Via S. Maria d'Abano, Via Latisana and Via Romana Aponense. Then it enters the municipality of Padua and continues on Via Romana Aponense, la Mandria, Via Armistizio, Ponte Isonzo, Via Isonzo, Via Goito, Piazzale Sacra Famiglia, Via Cernaia, Piazzale San Giovanni, Via Euganea, Ponte San Giovanni delle Navi, Via Vescovado, Via Vandelli, Piazza Duomo, Granguardia, Piazza dei Signori, Piazza della Frutta, Via Oberdan, Via VIII Febbraio, Via San Francesco, Via del Santo, Piazza del Santo, Via Luca Belludi and arrives at the finish line in Prato della Valle, the largest square in Europe.

# **PROHIBITIONS**

The race course will be completely closed to traffic. All side streets and all crossroads will be supervised by the local police who will prevent all other types of vehicles (bicycles, mopeds and motorcycles included) from travelling along the racecourse. Vehicles that are authorised to travel along the course will be issued a special pass by the Organization.

#### **TIMING**

The timing and the ranking of the race will be processed by EvoData with the MyLaps Bibtag system, based on a disposable bib chip. The chip is glued on the back of the bib number and should not be returned after the race.

# **TIME LIMITS**

The race course will be closed to traffic for a maximum of **6:30 hours**. Athletes who finish the race after this time limit will not be ranked.

# **PACERS**

Padova Marathon will provide pacers, that are athletes who will run at a constant pace to reach the finish line at a preestablished time: 3h00' - 3h15' - 3h30' - 3h45' - 4h00' - 4h15' - 4h30' - 4h45' - 5h00'.

At the start at the Euganeo Stadium the pacers will be inside the various start corrals and can be recognized by the word "pacer" on their t-shirt or by balloons of various colours.

# **REFRESHMENTS AND SPONGING**

In accordance with the World Athletics/FIDAL rulebook, there will be refreshment stations at the finish line and along the course. Sponging stations will also be available along the race course where set for the marathon.







#### WITHDRAWAL FROM THE RACE

Athletes who decide to quit the race should use the refreshment stations and sponging stations as meeting points. From there they will be taken to the finish line area in Prato della Valle, where they will be able to collect their personal bag.

#### **MEDICAL ASSISTANCE**

Along the marathon race course there are **two hospitals** (in Abano Terme and Padua). Medical assistance will be guaranteed along the entire length of the race course with medical assistance means, including two medical motorcycles. But we realise that every marathon runner knows his/her own limits and how to gauge his/her own strength in order to reach the finish line

Next to the Sanitary Service tent after the finish line, there will be a tent for information on marathon runners who have been aided along the race course.

#### **FINISH**

The finish line is located in Prato della Valle, Padua.

# **PRIZE MONEY LIST**

After the race the first three men and women will be prized on the main stage in Prato della Valle. The prize money of the Padova Marathon is established according to the rules of World Athletics, FIDAL, FISPES and the laws of the State and will be published on the website <a href="https://www.padovamarathon.com">www.padovamarathon.com</a>.

### Athletes with Runcard or Sport promotion affiliation card cannot be included in the money prize.

Money prizes for Italian and foreign athletes will be paid by bank transfer within 90 days. The Organization will send to the winners an online form to be filled in with personal details, tax code and bank details (including IBAN code).

## **MARATHON DIPLOMA**

Each participant will be able to download the marathon diploma from the website www.padovamarathon.com.

# **ELIMINATION**

The Organization reserves the right to eliminate any athlete from the race at any time for inappropriate behaviour.

throughout the world, in all forms and for all purposes, including their use in advertising and promotional materials, and for the length of time permitted by law, by regulations and by agreements in effect, including any extension of the aforementioned duration.

# **SOME PRACTICAL TIPS**

- We recommend the use of comfortable running shoes that have been broken in and tested on long distances. The use of new shoes should be avoided until they have taken the shape of the arch of your foot.
- Protect the parts of your body that may become irritated due to the repeated friction caused by running (armpits, groin, inner thighs, breasts).
- Use large amounts of moisturising cream (preferably petroleum jelly, i.e. Vaseline) to moisturise these parts of the body.
- For participants who will be staying at a hotel, we recommend that you remind the hotel staff of any special needs that you may have on the day of the race: an early breakfast, the possibility of leaving your baggage in their care until the end of the race, the possibility of taking a shower afterwards, etc.
